The annual congregational meeting will be on Wednesday May 19th at 7PM in the sanctuary.



The Celtic cross reminds us, as Presbyterians, of our historical roots in the British Isles dating back at least to the fifth century. *Post Tenebras Lux* is a Latin slogan from the 16th-century Protestant Reformation meaning *After Darkness*, *Light*.
