#### 8 THE NICENE CREED

## Love Your Enemies

MATTHEW 5:43-48

Lewis: The Sermon on the Mount is a sl\_\_\_\_\_

## 1. The Error v. 43

This is an actual d\_\_\_\_\_\_ of the law. It omits the "\_\_ y\_\_\_\_" part of the command. It adds: "h\_\_\_\_ your \_\_\_\_\_." Changed a command about \_\_\_\_\_ into a command about \_\_\_\_\_. They believed it was p\_\_\_\_\_\_ to hate one's enemies. Jesus rejects the "f\_\_\_\_\_ and f\_\_\_\_" neighbor plan.

## 2. The Correction (vv. 44-45)
