What Shall We Do?

THE ATHANASIAN CREED

PART 3

It is necessary to everlasting salvation that we also believe rightly in the Incarnation of our Lord Jesus Christ.

For the true Faith is, that we believe and confess, that our Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of God, is God and Man; God, of the substance of the Father, begotten before the worlds; and Man of the substance of his Mother, born in the world; Perfect God and perfect Man, of a rational soul and human flesh. Equal to the Father as regards his divinity; and less than the Father as regards his humanity;

Who, although he is God and Man, yet he is not two, but one Christ; One, not by conversion of the Godhead into flesh, but by taking of the humanity to himself; One, not by the blending of his essence, but by unity of his person. For as the reasonable soul and flesh is one man, so God and Man is one Christ;

He suffered for our salvation, descended into hell, rose again the third day from the dead. He ascended into heaven, he sits at the right hand of the Father, God Almighty, from whence he will come to judge the quick and the dead. At whose coming all men will rise again with their bodies and shall give account for their own works. And they that have done good shall go into life everlasting; and they that have done evil into everlasting fire.

This is the catholic Faith, which unless we hold to faithfully, we cannot be saved.
