WESTMINSTER CONFESSION OF FAITH CHAPTER 33

OF THE LAST JUDGMENT

God has appointed a day, wherein He will judge the world in righteousness by Jesus Christ, to whom all power and judgment is given of the Father. In which day, not only the apostate angels shall be judged; but likewise all persons, that have lived upon earth, shall appear before the tribunal of Christ, to give an account of their thoughts, words, and deeds; and to receive according to what they have done in the body, whether good or evil.

The end of God's appointing this day, is for the manifestation of the glory of His mercy in the eternal salvation of the elect; and of His justice in the damnation of the reprobate, who are wicked and disobedient. For then shall the righteous go into everlasting life, and receive that fullness of joy and refreshing which shall come from the presence of the Lord: but the wicked, who know not God, and obey not the gospel of Jesus Christ, shall be cast into eternal torments, and punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of His power.

As Christ would have us to be certainly persuaded that there shall be a day of judgment, both to deter all men from sin, and for the greater consolation of the godly in their adversity: so will He have that day unknown to men, that they may shake off all carnal security, and be always watchful, because they know not at what hour the Lord will come; and may be ever prepared to say, Come, Lord Jesus, come quickly. Amen.

Our Great Commission Focus this month is on Dr. Jody Collinge: a New Yorker and pediatrician who resides in and works from the resort city of Zihuatanejo on Mexico's Pacific Coast, northwest of Acapulco. Dr. Jody works with Global Community Health Evangelism Network, a ministry that serves in over 100 countries worldwide; and she develops training materials for Children's Community Health Evangelism, a member of the network.

Her day job takes her into squatter communities in the hills overlooking the City where Kids' Clubs have been established. In these Clubs, Bible Skills, English as a Second Language, and First Aid and Health skills are taught. Several church plants have emerged as a result of these Kid's Clubs. Her job also takes her to other countries to work with others who are similarly involved with Children's Ministries and to provide training.
